On Tuesday, August 27th a few of our philoptochos ladies gathered at our church's kitchen to make prosfora.

Prosphora, or "offering," is the bread that we use in the Divine Liturgy. The bread is leavened bread, and is made using a simple recipe: water, yeast, flour, and salt.

The loaf is "sealed" or "stamped" before it is baked.


Hope you all enjoy this selection. It has gotten excellent reviews and seems like a good pick for our group.


